Action Plan for Children with Severe Allergies or Life Threatening Conditions

- 1. No child having a severe allergy or life threatening condition shall attend Nourish Early Learning prior to having a medical plan complete and signed by the entire staff.
- 2. All classrooms inhabited by a child with a severe allergy or life threatening condition will have postings at their entrance.
- 3. All children with a severe allergy or life threatening condition will have a designated seat at lunch separate from all foods that may put them in danger.
- 4. All snacks served to a child having a severe allergy or life threatening condition will only contain items provided by the parent from a list of expectable foods provided to Nourish by the parents.
- 6. All children with severe allergies or life threatening conditions will be introduced to all staff members by their lead teacher to make certain the child is recognizable to all staff.
- 7. A picture of the child and the allergy stated, followed by the action plan completed by the parent, will be posted in the lunch preparation area.
- 8. Any child bearing a food allergy where an Epipen is needed will have a pen located in the activity room and another pen in the child's classroom.
