

Action Plan for Children with Severe Allergies or Life Threatening Conditions

1. No child having a severe allergy or life threatening condition shall attend Nourish Early Learning prior to having a medical plan complete and signed by the entire staff.
2. All classrooms inhabited by a child with a severe allergy or life threatening condition will have postings at their entrance.
3. All children with a severe allergy or life threatening condition will have a designated seat at lunch separate from all foods that may put them in danger.
4. All snacks served to a child having a severe allergy or life threatening condition will only contain items provided by the parent from a list of expectable foods provided to Nourish by the parents.
6. All children with severe allergies or life threatening conditions will be introduced to all staff members by their lead teacher to make certain the child is recognizable to all staff.
7. A picture of the child and the allergy stated, followed by the action plan completed by the parent, will be posted in the lunch preparation area.
8. Any child bearing a food allergy where an EpiPen is needed will have a pen located in the activity room and another pen in the child's classroom.
